


# Borderline Personality Disorder and Emotion Dysregulation



## Call for Papers

### Aggression and Antisociality: Development, Mechanisms, and Treatment across the Lifespan



This collection invites interdisciplinary contributions that examine aggression and antisociality in the context of personality pathology and related conditions.

We welcome studies employing clinical, translational, and experimental approaches to elucidate the affective, cognitive, interpersonal, and neurobiological processes underlying aggressive and antisocial behavior. Submissions may include dimensional models of personality and psychopathology (e.g., trait impulsivity, callousness, or emotion dysregulation), alongside work using traditional diagnostic frameworks. Longitudinal and developmental studies that trace the emergence and progression of aggression and antisociality across the lifespan are encouraged.

Equally, we seek contributions that evaluate or develop interventions aimed at preventing or reducing aggression or antisocial behavior, including psychotherapeutic, pharmacological, and community-based approaches. Studies exploring mechanisms of treatment response, moderators of change, and implementation in real-world settings are of particular interest. Studies focusing on the role of social, situational, and environmental factors are also welcome.

In addition to original empirical research, this collection will feature high-quality evidence syntheses, including systematic reviews and meta-analyses. Both empirical studies and reviews will be privileged

if they also include substantive theoretical elaboration or advancement.
