**Postdoctoral Researcher (100%; TV-L) for a period of 3 years,

The researcher will work in the DFG-funded project “Ideomotor Control of Anticipatory Action” granted to PD Dr. Oliver Herbort, which connects the domains of cognitive psychology and motor control.

The position requires the planning and preparation of experiments (including motion capture and virtual reality setups), data analyses, publishing results in international journals, and presenting at national and international conferences. The ideal candidate has a PhD in psychology or in a related field. We expect a background in cognitive psychology or motor control. The candidate has practical experience in experimental psychology, has programming skills (e.g., Basic, C#), is experienced in statistical data analysis (e.g., Matlab, SPSS), and has the ability to work independently.

The project is situated at the Department of Cognitive Psychology of the University of Würzburg (Lehrstuhl für Psychologie III), which offers an excellent, stimulating work environment and covers a broad range of topics and methods (e.g., motion capture, EEG, Eye-Tracking, VR). The candidate has opportunity for further qualification (Habilitation) in the context of the project.

The University of Würzburg is an equal opportunity employer and aims to increase the proportion of women in science. Applications by women are particularly welcome. Applicants with disabilities are preferred if qualification is equal.

Travel expenses cannot be covered. This position is suitable for part-time employment.
