The German grades range from 1.0 to 6.0, with the following letter grades (A - F) recommended by the European Commission are used. ECTS-grades:

German Grading	ECTS Grades	Rating
1.0 – 1.3	A	excellent - outstanding performance with only minor errors
1.7 – 2.0	B	very good - above the average standard but with some errors
2.3 – 2.7	C	good - generally solid work with a number of notable errors
3.0 – 3.3	D	satisfactory - fair but with significant shortcomings
3.7 – 4.0	E	sufficient - performance meets the minimum criteria
4.7	FX	fail - some more work required before the credit can be awarded
5.0 – 6.0	F	fail: considerable further work is required)
