The following sections give an overview on the available modules. In the first column, you can find the long name and the abbreviation of the modules. The number of ECTS points can be found in column 2 and column 3 specifies the number of semesters of the courses. In the last column, there are additional hints on the type of courses, if it is graded and if the module is split into submodules. F. e. "Educational Psychology" (06-PSY-PAPSY) comprises two different modules that can be attended independently from each other. And both modules again include two different courses each.

Most modules include two different courses (e.g., a lecture and a seminar) and all modules are taught every term. The concrete name of the seminar might vary from term to term and usually, there are several different parallel groups for the seminar of a module. 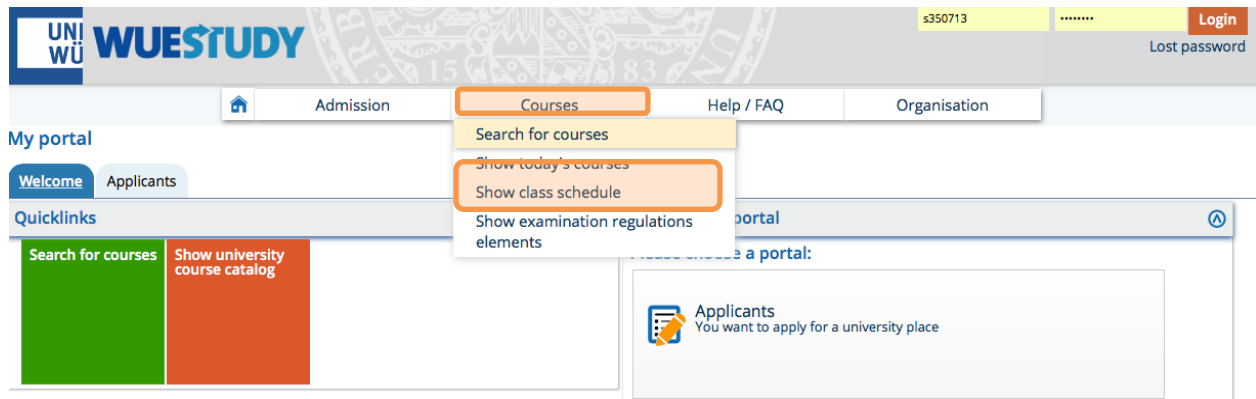


Step 1

Step 2


Please choose the correct semester in the course catalogue. You can choose between winter term (beginning in October) and summer term (beginning in April).

After clicking on the degree, you first get a list of courses of different studies, choose “Psychologie” and next “Bachelor (180 ECTS) Psychologie – 2015” or, if you chose “Master- und Aufbaustudiengänge”, “Master (120 ECTS) Psychologie – 2015”.
